- When you **pay in full** for SCUBA class and provide your legal name, date of birth, physical address, email address and cell phone number, we can register you for class. *(E-mail address is your user name.)*
- You will receive an email with a temporary password until you create your own. This expires in 24 hours. If you don't open it, call us for a reset.
- Complete your SCUBA course academics on the app or **divessi.com** Log OUT of ALL devices to upload your completion record.
- We require the final exam of all courses be taken in the presence of an instructor. The online exam is good practice.
- You MUST complete the online academics BEFORE going to open water.

Continuing Education Courses

- Once you have a login password, your continuing education courses will appear in the appropriate app under "my courses". You will not get an email.
 - You have 24 hours to acknowledge receipt of the course materials.

SCUBA Education in 2025 @ Harry's Dive Shop

- 1. Learning to scuba dive is about safety first the fun follows.
- 2. The Medical Questionnaire with **all** answers truthfully answered NO or a Physician's Written Approval is required prior to any in-water SCUBA instruction. **(PA or NP not accepted in LA)**
- 3. Online academics must be completed prior to going to open water.
- 4. Be properly prepared to begin your class ON-TIME or reschedule with penalty.
- 5. Failure to show up or canceling class inside 24 hours is an automatic **forfeit** of tuition. **Rescheduling or makeup classes incur additional cost.**
- 6. ONLY those paying for class and filling out the student folder may get in the water. (If you are not part of the class, you do not get in the water.)
- 7. Children 10 and 11 years old are limited to private lessons with a ratio of 2 kids to 1 Instructor. Though we will teach the young children, we cannot commit to certifying them in Florida.
- 8. Children 12-17 (under 18) must have a legal guardian sign the student folder.
- 9. You have **ONE YEAR** to complete ALL certification requirements from the date of initially signing the student folder. This includes open water dives. *Thereafter, you start from the beginning.*
- 10. The initial, unassisted swimming requirements are non-negotiable.
- 11. Until certified, student divers may only use SCUBA equipment from Harry's Dive Shop.
- 12. The plastic SCUBA diver certification card is available at additional cost.
- 13. We aim to create capable, confident divers making smart decisions. To achieve this goal, we promise to work with you until you are comfortable diving without professional guidance.
- 14. No Money, No Place Saved We cannot not hold space for an activity without money paid.
- 15. We send you the online academics AFTER full payment of your SCUBA class.
- 16. No refunds for unfinished classes.
- 17. When you purchase a weight integrated BC from us, we will buy back only your belt *(not lead)* provided you did not cut or write on it.
- 18. We CANNOT refund any equipment after it has been used.
- 19. Final exams are taken in the presence of an instructor.
- 20. Online academics MUST be completed before going to open water.

In-Water SCUBA Orientation \$150

Students provide medical clearance, swimsuit, towel, mask, snorkel, SCUBA fins, boots and weighted belt. The key to success in any equipment intensive activity is proper FIT and FUNCTION. Let us guide and assist you in making the right choices. Be prepared to begin your IN-WATER orientation on-time.

If the answer to anything on the medical questionnaire is YES, you NEED physician's approval (not PA or NP) before using compressed air.

From the date of signing the student folder, you have <u>ONE YEAR</u> to complete ALL requirements for SCUBA certification *including the dives in OPEN WATER*.

During the in-water orientation, fill out and sign the student folder, discuss available schedules, learn what is expected of you, exhibit your *swimming* abilities without assistance (no wetsuits, no goggles, no mask, no fins – just you and your swimsuit).

You will use **SCUBA in the shallow water**, learn what size BC fits best, how much lead you need to be neutrally buoyant and finally, use your personally provided mask, snorkel, scuba fins, booties and weighted belt to be sure they fit properly and are appropriate to serve your needs as a SCUBA diver in OPEN WATER.


The open water checkout dive weekend is part of your SCUBA training. It is designed to be fun yet has required skills, time and dive obligations. Our plans are to make 3+ dives in cool fresh spring water from shore and 1 or 2 dives in the Gulf of Mexico from a boat.

Each diver provides: mask, snorkel, SCUBA fins, boots, dive knife retrievable and usable with one hand, good whistle, personal SMB, underwater flashlight, *regulator with gauges and power inflator, *cold water wetsuit, *adequate lead *BC with alternate air source or separate octopus, dive computer and *2 full tanks each day. **rentable*

Open Water student divers may only use SCUBA equipment rented or purchased from Harry's Dive Shop until after certified.

Divers are to KEEP their air supply with them at all times and Never share air with an uncertified diver.

Certification skills dives are \$50 per specialty on top of trip cost. 24+ logged dives and 4+ specialties required for Advanced Open Water SCUBA Diver RECOGNITION Certification.

Navigation & Limited Visibility \$450

(Paraphrased from a DAN article)

For many, the love of SCUBA stems from a drive to explore foreign environments. Nowhere else on Earth can we become more lost than in a liquid, while constantly monitoring safety techniques, breathing gas, buoyancy, horizontal trim, depth and time.

Different underwater environments warrant different navigation strategies. Every diver should be able to successfully navigate and find their way back to the exit point.

Trained divers use a combination of compass, natural navigation, kick cycles and running lines along with cognitive mapping and understanding water currents.

Limited visibility slows progress by reducing speed and kick cycles.

Gently tilting your head and partially flooding your mask gives an easy reminder of which is UP. There may come a time when you must rely solely on equipment for navigation.

At such times, skills practice, training and preparation are needed to navigate successfully.

Wreck & Deep >60' - \$450

Overhead environments are confined spaces where a direct ascent to the surface is not possible. Never enter an overhead environment without proper training. Using a compass on top of or inside a wreck may be next to impossible due to metal components causing deviation and faulting readings. Immediately on descent, pay attention to the physical orientation of the wreck. Mastering skills and techniques conserves energy, air and stress. There's no shortcut to overcoming a poor skills base.

The deeper we dive, the faster we use our breathing gas. While inside the SCUBA cylinder, the gas is affected by temperature. Surrounding pressure increases with depth.

EXAMPLE: If a tank of air lasts 3 hours at the surface, with all other conditions the same, the same tank of air would last only 1¹/₂ hours at 33' sea water. At 66' sea water, it would last 1 hour only 45 minutes at 99 feet. Etcetera.
